Khanya Christian Women's Outreach branch of Meals on Wheels in Kwadwesi, Port Elizabeth is managing to feed 300 community members out of a small, bad-smelling container.

"We wish to have a building where we can do our work as the container we operate in has become a health hazard for children because men use the container as a place to urinate against," says branch manager Mrs. Nolufefe Zazini.

They would like the container to be fenced. They also need enough money to pay their staff. A car is needed for deliveries. They would love to have services such as water and electricity.

"We pay somebody for transport and pay someone nearby for water," says Mrs. Zazini. "We cook on gas stoves. It's a struggle. Sadly we have a counselor who could not be bothered with anybody in his community." It is therefore up to non-profit organizations like Meals on Wheels to care for people.
